**Inauguration of the "Guest Tour Series"**  
**A new activity developed by the Education**  
**Department of the Musée d'art contemporain**

Montreal, May 6, 1993. Wednesday, May 12, 1993, from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm, Sylvère Lotringer, Professor of French literature at Columbia University in New York, and critic in residence at the California Institute for the Arts, will give a guided tour of works presented in the *Geneviève Cadieux* exhibition, on view at the Musée until May 30. This tour will be followed by a screening of the video *Voyage to Rodez*, directed by New Zealand-born American artist **Chris Kraus** about the life of actor/writer Antonin Artaud. A seminar about Artaud entitled "Journées internationales Antonin Artaud" will also be held, May 13 to 15 at UQAM.

Professor Lotringer starts off the "Guest Tour Series", an all-new project created and organized by the Musée's Department of Education who will invite, at regular intervals, guest-speakers from diversified cultural backgrounds.
