The Musée d'art contemporain is a provincially owned corporation funded by the Ministère de la Culture, des Communications et de la Condition féminine du Québec. The Musée receives additional financial support from the Department of Canadian Heritage and the Canada Council for the Arts.

This inaugural Triennial presents 135 new works by 38 Québec artists in a variety of media: painting, sculpture, photography, video and installation. For the first time in the Musée's history, all the galleries will be taken up by the same exhibition—the most ambitious it has ever mounted. The title of this year's show comes from the famous quotation attributed to Antoine Lavoisier: Nothing is lost, nothing is created, everything is transformed.
