Rodney Graham est présent sur la scène musicale depuis les années 1970. En 1978, avec Frank Raminez (Frank Johnston), Ian Wallace et Jeff Wall, entre autres, il forme UJ3RK5 un groupe "new-wave-art-rock" qui se taillera le statut de groupe culte sur le scène musicale canadienne. Puis, en 1995, il fonde le groupe rock *Volumizer*. Il a enregistré plusieurs albums, celui avec UJ3RK5 au début des années 1980 est maintenant extrêmement rare, le long jeu *Rodney Graham 'Gettin' it Together in the Country* avec la chanson de sa pièce *The Phonokinetoscope* est épuisé depuis longtemps. Entre juin 1998 et février 2000, il a enregistré les 17 chansons de son CD *The Bed-Bug, Love Buzz And Other Short Songs in the Popular Idiom*. En 2000, il a enregistré *What is Happy, Baby?* puis *Live in London, Rock is Hard et Gaga for GIGI* avec *Volumizer*. Son plus récent CD est *Never Tell a Pal a Hard Luck Story (You'll Only Get a Hard Luck Story in Return)*. En concert, Rodney Graham est entouré de 4 autres musiciens David Carswell, guitare, Bezz, basse, Pete Bourne, batterie, Paddy Ryan, claviers.

Rodney Graham's activities has a musician dates back to the 1970s. In 1978, with Frank Raminez (Frank Johnston), Ian Wallace and Jeff Wall, among others, he formed UJ3RK5 a "new-wave-art-rock" group that developed a cult following on the Canadian music scene. Then, in 1995, he founded the rock group *Volumizer*. He has released several albums the U-J3RK5' album recorded in the early 1980s is now extremely rare, the *Rodney Graham 'Gettin' it Together in the Country 10"* LP is long out-of-print, and features the song that plays during his *The Phonokinetoscope* piece. Between June 1998 and February 2000, Graham recorded the seventeen songs on his CD *The Bed-Bug, Love Buzz and Other Short Songs in the Popular Idiom*. In 2000, he recorded *What Is Happy, Baby ?* and subsequently *Live in London, Rock Is Hard, and Volumizer's CD Gaga for GIGI*. His latest CD is *Never Tell a Pal a Hard Luck Story (You'll Only Get a Hard Luck Story in Return)*. The four musicians playing with Rodney Graham are David Carswell, guitar, Beez, bass, Pete Bourne, drums, Paddy Ryan, keyboards.
