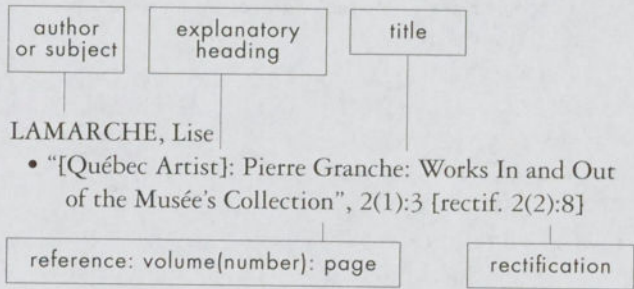

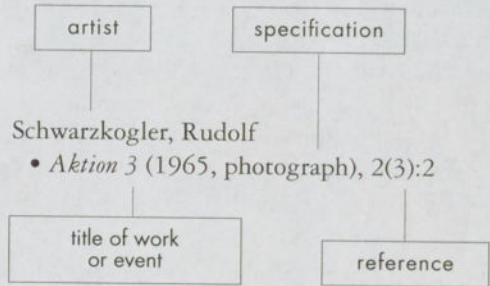
NOTE

The index has two parts: an author/subject index and an iconographic index (table of illustrations). ■ The author/subject index covers all of the articles in *Le Journal du Musée d'art contemporain*, except the Calendar. The headings are: authors of articles, titles of exhibitions or events, names of artists, and subjects (concepts). Authors' names are in capitals. Titles of exhibitions, events or works are in italics. Any further information needed to complete the reference is in brackets (for example, headings, titles or rectifications). ■ The iconographic index lists all the works and events illustrated in *Le Journal*. The headings are: artist's name or title of the event, and medium. Titles of works or events are in italics. ■ The form of the references is: bold characters for volume and number, and regular characters for pages. ■ *Lyne Des Ruisseaux*
